Residents (18 years of age or older) of Radnor Township and select neighborhoods contiguous to the University (such as County Line Road, Broughton Lane, or Spring Mill Road) can purchase a Friends of Villanova card for a \$25 annual fee which grants access to the facilities and programs listed below.

Friends of Villanova cards must be purchased in person at the Wildcard Office located in Dougherty Hall. Individuals must present a valid photo ID to verify address information at the time of initial sign-up and at each annual renewal. Friends of Villanova cards are not transferable.

Please note that Friends of Villanova cards can not be purchased or renewed during New Student Orientation and the first week of classes during the Fall Semester.

Aquatic Facilities

Personal Training

Fitness Centers

Users must be 18 years of age or older and must have a valid Friends of Villanova card.

Parking Information

Friends of Villanova may purchase a parking permit to park their vehicle on campus. Permits costs \$40 annually and can be purchased in the Wildcard Office located in Dougherty Hall. Only individuals with valid Friends of Villanova cards may purchase a parking permit.

Permits allow parking on a space available basis in the Rear Pavilion Parking Lot, the Rear St. Mary's Parking Lot and the South Campus Parking Lot. More information on campus parking policies can be found at the Department of Public Safety website.
